



SILVER LAKE BOATING RULES – SIMPLIFIED

- **NO-WAKE RULES**
 - **No-Wake Sunset to 10am: Idle Speed EVERYWHERE on the lake.**
 - **No-Wake Area: Idle Speed on the LAND SIDE of No-Wake Buoys.**
- **MOTORIZED BOAT OPERATOR EDUCATION AND MINIMUM AGE**
 - **EVERYONE born on or after January 1, 1989 needs to pass the boating safety course.**
 - **Must be 12 years old to operate a motorized boat without an adult.**
- **“KEEP CLEAR” RULES**
 - **Faster boats need to stay 100 feet away from slower boats.**
 - **Motorized boats at speed need to stay 100 feet away from non-motorized boats, including motorized boats at anchor or drifting.**
- **LIFEJACKETS**
 - **One lifejacket for everyone aboard the boat.**
 - **Includes paddle boards and pedal boats.**
 - **Only sailboard operators are excluded.**
- **WHEN TOWING a tube, skier, wakeboarder, etc.**
 - **Travel COUNTERCLOCKWISE on the lake side of the No-Wake Buoys.**
 - **All people being towed need to wear lifejackets.**
 - **Need wide-angle mirror OR a spotter different from the boat driver.**
 - **No more than two tow lines.**
 - **No more than maximum number of passengers in a tube.**
 - **Minimum 3-person capacity for PWC's used for towing.**
